5. Local Matters

My Care Choices Register

This was talked about at a recent Local Health Forum meeting and there is also an article about it in the Parish Magazine.

My Care Choices is a database that can only be accessed by healthcare professionals caring for those that are registered on it. It began 5 years ago as part of a government initiative to provide a way for those individuals approaching end of life to record their preferences in regard to treatment. It had been found that there were positive outcomes to be had when patients had conversations with their GPs and families about their end of life wishes; thus, My Care Choices had been set up to enable such wishes to be recorded.

The speaker reported that the register currently had 3600 people on it. She then went on to say that not everyone that used the register were necessarily at the end of life. There were other times when such conversations were appropriate and she cited dementia as one such instance, saying that it was important for the patient to record their wishes whilst they were still able to do so.

Clacton Urgent Care Facility

At the PPG Liaison meeting they said that this would be opening in October and they were looking from input from people in the area what other facilities would be useful to have in the redesigned Clacton Hospital.
